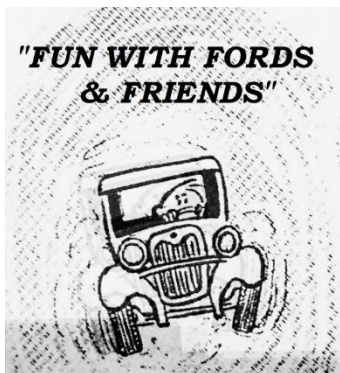
- 6 June, General Meeting.

Here is a short history lesson.

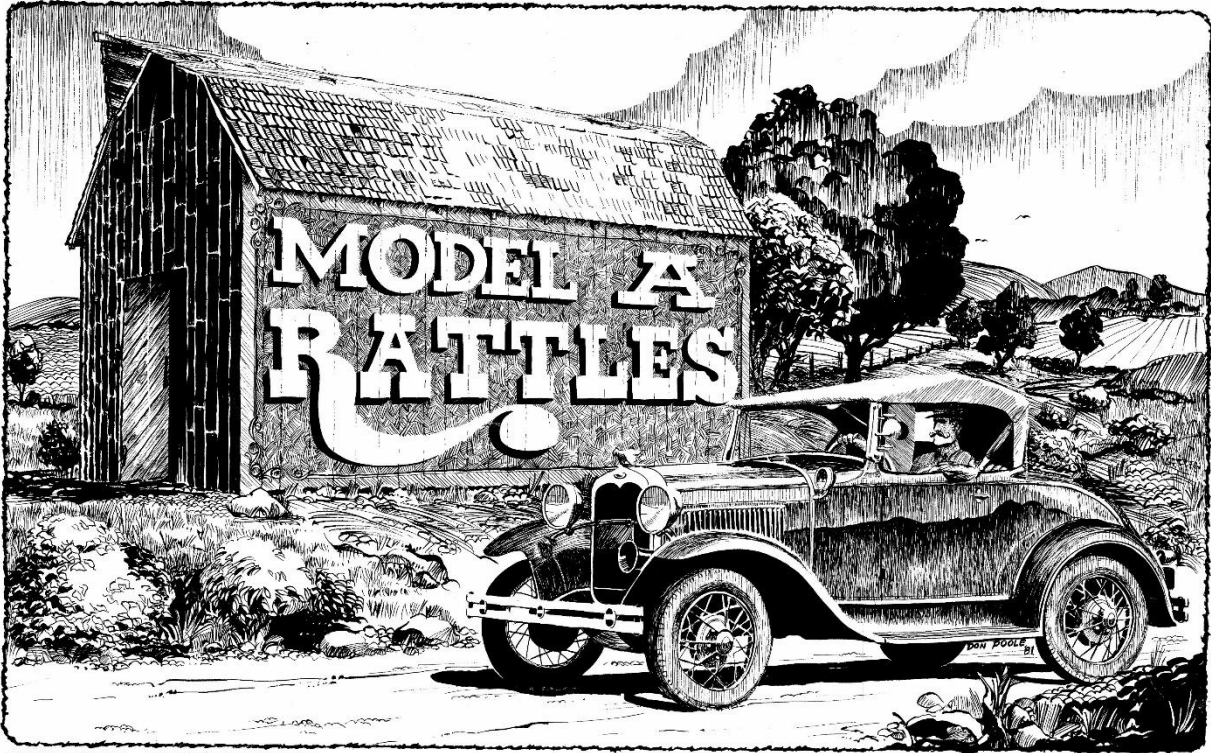
